5. What is the status of the Capercaillie, a European bird?
6. Looking on the Main Floor, how many Passenger Pigeons does the museum have on display?
7. Which species of reptile is on display in the "Endangered Species" display?
8. What cousin is displayed nearby to the answer in number 7?
9. The Bald Eagle came off the endangered species list in 2007. Name one other bird that is still on the United States endangered list.
